

## 2025 VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES KINDERGARTEN TO YEAR 6

The information below sets out the structure of the Voluntary Contributions for Yanchep Lagoon Primary School for 2025 - **\$60** for every student from Kindergarten through to Year 6 – **that is only \$1.50 per week**. Voluntary Contributions are a way of enhancing Government schools' capacity to add value to students' learning experiences.

In 2024 our overall collection rate for Voluntary Contributions and Charges increased to 42.44%. In 2025 we would like to achieve as close as possible to 100%. The reality is that if Contributions and Charges are not paid, it directly impacts upon the depth and breadth of resources available for students. Your support in ensuring that all students can enjoy the variety in programs at Yanchep Lagoon Primary School is vital.

Payment for Voluntary Contributions can be made at the front office at any time during school hours either in person using cash or EFTPOS or direct deposit.
